

# The one Hundred Twenty-Fifth Anniversary

The One Hundred Twenty-Fifth Anniversary will start at Wilbur Wright's birthplace, in Hartsville, Indiana, and it will focus on the parents of Wilbur and Orville (Bishop Milton Wright and Susan Koerner Wright) and the rest of the Wright family. Aside from the final days' celebrations at Kitty Hawk, which the First Flight Society will coordinate with the National Park Service, the details of what will take place at each of the other locations will primarily be at the discretion of the local organizations.

## The Wright Route

The Wright Route was created in partnership with several organizations to showcase the Wright Brothers' journey from Dayton to Kitty Hawk. The route highlights sites in various cities along the way, celebrating the 125th Anniversary.

The One Hundred Twenty-Fifth Anniversary will involve a pilgrimage starting at Wilbur Wright's birthplace. Local organizations will primarily decide the details at each location. A travel package may be available.



## Celebration Schedule

### Day 1: Dec. 11, 2028

Wilbur's Birthplace: This is an appropriate place to begin the 125th Anniversary celebrations

### Day 2 & 3: (Dec. 12 & 13, 2028)

Dayton Ohio: Dayton, Ohio is the Wright Brothers' hometown and base for their aviation inventions.

### Day 4: (Dec. 14, 2028)

Norfolk/Hampton Area: Wilbur traveled to Kitty Hawk via trains and a steamer, arriving in the evening. Hampton has significant aerospace centers.

### Day 5: (Dec. 15, 2028)

Elizabeth City, NC: Wilbur traveled from Dayton to Elizabeth City and found a boat to Kitty Hawk. Elizabeth City has an Aviation Trail and a collegiate aviation program.

### Day 6 & 7: (Dec. 16 & 17, 2028)

Kitty Hawk, NC: The celebrations on Outer Banks culminate on December 17th at the Wright Brothers National Memorial. Other events are planned for December 16th. Stakeholders will agree on a plan.
